Pasco Tax Collector Offices Will Be Closed on Saturday June 17, 2017 Due to Statewide Computer Upgrades

Tax Collector Mike Fasano announces that on Saturday June 17, 2017 the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will be upgrading its data processing equipment. As a result, the Pasco County Tax Collector's Office will be unable to process transactions on that date. Due to these circumstances, which are beyond the control of the tax collector's office, all Pasco County tax collector offices will be closed on June 17, 2017.
